Yellow Duck - 2 lines

Green Frog - 2 lines

Purple Cat - 2 lines

Blue Horse - 10 lines

White Dog - 2 lines

Black Sheep - 2 lines

Goldfish - 2 lines

Teacher - 2 lines

Narrator: Brown Bear, Brown Bear. what do you see?

Brown Bear: I see a red bird looking at me.

Narrator: Red Bird, Red Bird, what do you see?

Red Bird: I see a yellow duck looking at me.

Narrator: Yellow Duck, Yellow Duck, what do you see?

Yellow Duck: I see a green frog looking at me.

Narrator: Green Frog, Green Frog, what do you see?

Green Frog: I see a purple cat looking at me.

Narrator: Purple Cat, Purple Cat, what do you see?

Purple Cat: I see a Blue horse looking at me.

Narrator: Blue Horse, Blue Horse What do you see?

Blue Horse- I see a White Dog looking at me

Narrator: White Dog, White Dog, what do you see?

White Dog: I see a black sheep looking at me.

Narrator: Black Sheep, Black Sheep, what do you see?

Black Sheep: I see a goldfish looking at me.

Narrator: Goldfish, Goldfish, what do you see?

Goldfish: I see a teacher looking at me.

Narrator: Teacher, Teacher, what do you see?

Teacher: I see children looking at me.

Narrator: Children, Children, what do you see?

All: We see a brown bear, a red bird, a yellow duck, a green frog, a purple cat, a blue Horse, a white dog, a black sheep, a goldfish, and a teacher looking at us. That's what we see!
