Left, right, left, right. We walk silently one by one.




Tsipara mfikira mpia! Nitsopara gari hu endra mbiyo rahana hayi mindru!

I just got a new idea. I will get a car to go faster!




Wasi karisifanya fidjo mawuri zinyama zangina. Luha yatu de ya harufu, uvundro, na uvushe.

I love cakes and all kinds of sweets, just like you.




Usitsaha niwone hu fanya hazi? Wami mtiti swafi rahana wawe be tsina nguvu swafi.
